A Candidate for membership into the Certification Board must submit an application to serve on the Certification Board and must meet one of the following requirements:

- An Associate's degree in Safety or an associated discipline with 17 years experience;
- A Bachelor's degree in Safety or an associated discipline with a minimum of 15 years of experience;
- A Master's degree in Safety or an associated discipline with a minimum of 12 years experience;
- A Doctorate degree in Safety or an associated discipline with a minimum of 10 years experience; or
- An individual working within the safety field with no degree, but having a minimum of 20 years experience.

The members of the WSO Certification meet or exceed all of these requirements with a combined 500+ years experience and numerous degrees among them. Many of them hold multiple WSO certifications, as well as credentials from other certifying organizations, and their areas of specialization cover a wide range of expertise.

At the time of privatisation and following privatisation, WAPDA divested 36% of its shareholding in the Company to the strategic investor. In August 2013, the strategic investor sold its entire shareholding in the Company to local corporate entities and individuals. In February 2005, the Privatisation Commission (on behalf of WAPDA) sold another 18% of WAPDA shareholding in the Company to the General Public. On April 18, 2005 the Company was formally listed on the Pakistan Stock Exchange (formerly the Karachi Stock Exchange, the Lahore Stock Exchange and the Islamabad Stock Exchange).

In Australia she has successfully contributed to the advancement of workplace safety and health and the safety profession through the excellence of her teaching and professional involvement work. In recognition of the excellence of her work, in 2018, she was Awarded Life Membership of the Safety Institute of Australia. Since becoming a Member of World Safety Organization Dr. Jansz has had published 28 articles in the World Safety Journal, one in the World Safety Organization Newsletter and had 6 World Safety Organization conference papers published in the World Safety Organization conference proceedings. Dr. Jansz has presented papers at 10 World Safety Conferences and 29 other international conferences and seminars. She has a total of 130 publications on workplace safety and health published internationally which have been used to share her knowledge.

One of the books that Dr. Jansz published 3 chapters in was called Sick building syndrome in public buildings and workplaces.
